Dear Families,

In unit one, we will review the alphabet. Your child needs to be able to say or sing the alphabet from A to Z, as well as identify the letter and sound it makes. The vowels (pictured in orange) are a, e, i, o, u. The rest of the letters are called consonants (pictured in yellow).

It is also very important for your child to write the letters correctly. We use the writing grid to help us. You can see the correct formations below!
