Unit Eight

Dear Family:

We shall continue to work with short vowel words, however, we are now ready to add consonant blends. A blend is two consonants together that each make a sound, as in the word "s t o p" - the /s/ and the /t/ each make a sound. A blend is different from a digraph which has two letters but only one sound, such as in the word "shop" - the /sh/ makes only one sound. Your child will learn a digraph blend. A digraph blend is a digraph blended with another consonant such as n and ch in the word lunch, or sh and r in the word shred.
